Family Toolkit 'Seeking Change'

We designed this toolkit as a support for families who want brief interventions for dealing with their family members addictive behaviour. It uses basic motivational interviewing techniques to help the family change their current approach and this can then be reviewed in a group setting.

Anyone worried about the drug or alcohol use of a loved one/family member.

How do I access this service?

People can access this service in their local area as one-to-one sessions or over the phone and online if they prefer. There is no cost for this service.
